- Coordinating with team members to support seamless service delivery.
- Supporting program development, process improvement, and service expansion statewide.

**Education requirements:** Required: Associate degree or higher in a related field. Preferred: Bachelor's or master's in Special Education, Vision Rehabilitation, Assistive Technology, Deaf-Blind Services, or related areas.

**Experience requirements:** At least two (2) years of experience providing technology instruction, adaptive skills training, or accessibility support for individuals who are blind, low vision, or Deaf-Blind.

**Licensures and certifications:** Preferred certifications (any combination welcome): Certified Assistive Technology Instructional Specialist (CATIS), Teacher of Students with Visual Impairments (TVI), Teacher of Students with Deaf-Blindness, Vision Rehabilitation Therapist (VRT), Certified Low Vision Therapist (CLVT).

**Required knowledge and skills:** Strong knowledge of assistive technology for blind, low vision, and Deaf-Blind users, including screen readers, magnification, mobile accessibility, braille displays, and communication tools. Ability to teach technology skills with patience and clarity, supported by strong communication, organizational, and problem-solving skills. Must be able to work independently and travel statewide between assigned sites.
